Description. Learning Clinical Reasoning uses a case-based approach to teach students the basics of clinical reasoning. The first section explains the chief components of the clinical reasoning process, such as generating and refining diagnostic hypotheses, using and interpreting diagnostic tests, assembling a working diagnosis, therapeutic decision-making, and examining and applying evidence, and also includes a discussion of cognitive errors.

### Learning Clinical Reasoning

As the previously mentioned cases demonstrate, there are numerous possibilities for diagnoses. In addition to the clinical reasoning associated with DHDx, the dental hygiene practitioner must then address management reasoning.20 Once the DHDx is presented, the care plan is addressed with the patient.

### Teaching clinical reasoning: case-based and coached.

This paper intends to provide a reflection upon a case study of 'Alison', who is a 38-year-old single mother of two. It uses the clinical reasoning cycle as a framework to explicitly discuss the situation and learnings from the mental health assessment (MSE) of Alison by utilizing the clinical reasoning cycle (CRC) and referencing to the components of MSE upon watching the video.

### Mental Health Assessment Case Study Using Clinical ...

Use a reasoning strategy (deductive v. inductive) to process the information in the clinical context of the case. Deductive reasoning works from general to specific. We develop hypotheses to explain a case problem and apply collected information to test the hypotheses in order to try and confirm or exclude a hypothesis.
