Texas Medicaid will pay for a nursing home, assisted living, or home health care when a patient needs skilled nursing care and qualifies financially. In 2019, a single person's monthly income cannot be higher than \$2,313 and assets cannot be higher than \$2,000.

The legislation applies in respect of care homes; it sets out fire safety responsibilities and seeks to ensure the safety of persons (whether they are employees, residents, visitors or others) from harm caused by fire. 9. LICENSING RULES FOR FAMILY AND GROUP CHILD CARE HOMES

A Group Child Care Home license allows a provider to care or supervise from 7 to 12 minor children in a private home for less than 24 hours a day unattended by a parent or legal guardian. The limit on the number of children does not include children who are related to an adult member of the family by blood, marriage or adoption.

Nursing homes and assisted living facilities in Pennsylvania are expensive, and even alternative long-term care like home health care can be costly. In 2017, the median annual cost of a private room in a nursing home in Pennsylvania was \$120,085.

Night care—Care for a child between the hours of 7 p.m. and 7 a.m. Nonrenewal—The written refusal of the Department to issue a certificate of compliance to a legal entity previously granted a certificate of compliance at the same location.
