Dr Deming's System of Profound Knowledge was based on four principles which he documented in his 1992 work The New Economics. Deming estimated that management was responsible for more than 85% of the causes of variation. This formed his central message to the Japanese. Deming's 14 points for management. Deming created 14 points which provide a framework to developing knowledge in the workplace and can be used to guide long term business plans and aims.

These two success elements, leadership and commitment, are central keys to cost-effective excellence. As we review the seven principles of effective cost management, it becomes clear that excellence in each depends on what business strategist W. Edwards Deming called profound knowledge.

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
